## **Resolution**

### **Establishment of a Political Committee on (European) Education and Culture**

**Education and Culture are crucial in the course of framing a European citizenship. Both topics are also related to the question of a European public sphere. Many of EMI's members are implementing actions and activities in the fields of (European) education and culture. Based on the expression of interest by several Members in the topics, confirmed by the questionnaire launched by the EMI Secretariat, the Federal Assembly asks the Board and the Secretariat to establish a Political Committee on (European) Education and Culture.**

#### **1) What will be the main topics?**

- Integration of the activities of EMI's members
- Transnational educational projects
- Cultural heritage
- European studies as part of curricula
- Development of European schools in the member states
- "Europeability" of school teachers and vocational instructors
- Non-Formal Education
- Peace Education

#### **2) What are the key documents?**

- EMI Questionnaire Europe@School
- EMI Working Plan 2012/13

#### **3) Who should be co-working in the Political Committee?**

- Nominated representatives from EMI Members
- Each EMI Member nominates a representative to monitor the debates both within his/her organisation of origin and on the international level;
- The representatives will be in charge of feeding the debates within the PC with discussions, positions, press releases, and activities organised by his/her home organisation;
- Additional representatives from national councils monitor the general debate within their country
- Other representatives from Members
- Other members are invited to follow and contribute to the online debates; if they wish to do so, they will have to subscribe to the respective online space (to be specified)
- Profile: participants should have an expertise and/or interest in (transnational) educational or cultural projects

#### **6) What does the PC seek to contribute to?**

- To the drafting of statements/declarations (in consultation with the EMI Secretary General)
- To EMI Board discussions and decisions by making specific proposals
- To broadening the debate of meetings and EMI briefing by inviting external experts



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- To the facilitation of networking activities between EMI Members regarding joint activities, common platforms etc. (e.g. for the European Competition or other school related projects)
